Objectives:

- Green Micred Pathways will provide a micro-credential green skills framework approved by experts from industry, education and training, which can facilitate adults to reskill/upskill within a lifelong learning paradigm to improve employment opportunities.
- The project consortium which include partners from industry, universities, adult education, VET, and agencies will provide a multilevel perspective to cocreate the micro-credential framework, platform, teaching and learning resources to support low skilled adults gain recognised micro-credentials for upskilling/reskilling.
- The Green Micred Pathways project team benchmarked adult education policy in the six consortium countries (Sweden, Ireland, Bulgaria, Spain, N. Macedonia, Latvia) and explored emerging green skills to ensure that learning outcomes are linked to the micro-credentials framework.
- A digital learning platform aligned to the European Qualifications Framework Level 4 requirements is being developed. The project will pilot and test the outcomes in order to develop learning material for teachers/trainers to be used in the training of low-skilled adults.
